



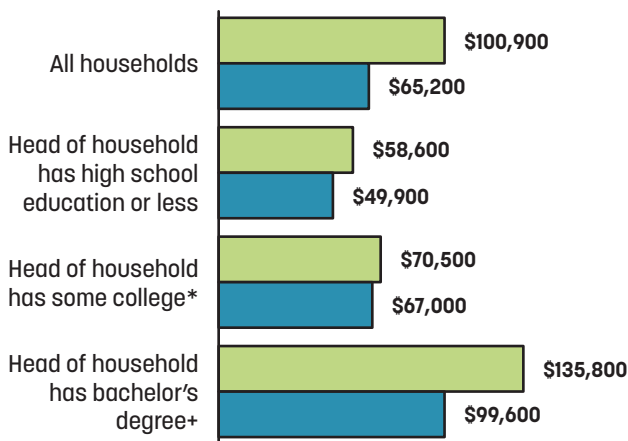
# A COLLEGE EDUCATION PROVIDES A LIFETIME OF VALUE generations

 ■ No parent with bachelor's degree



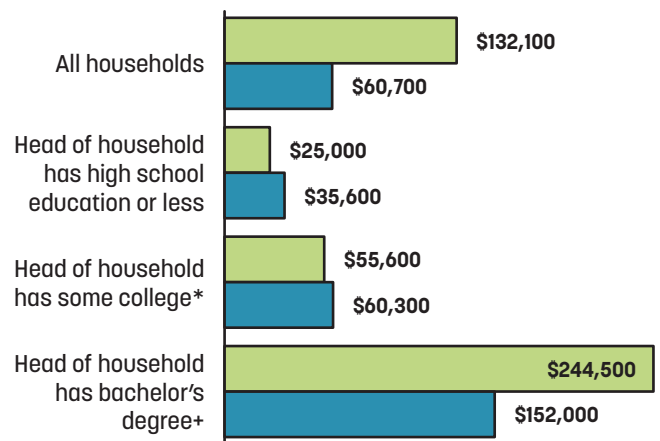

 ■ No parent with bachelor's degree



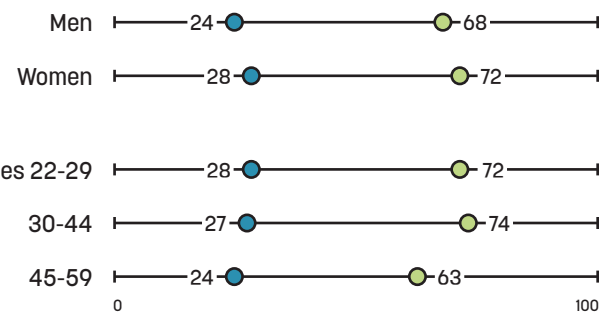
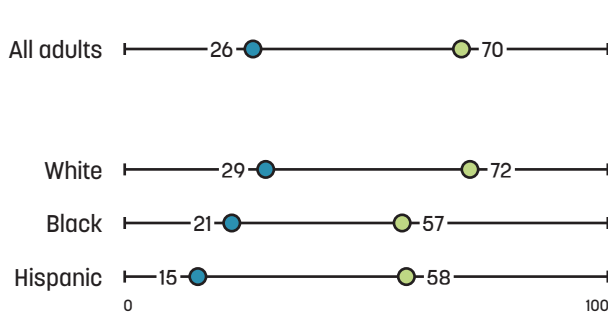
