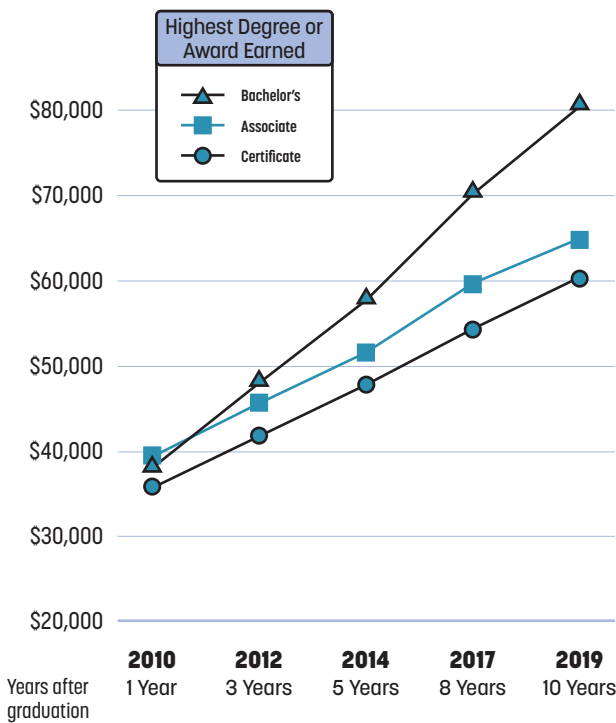

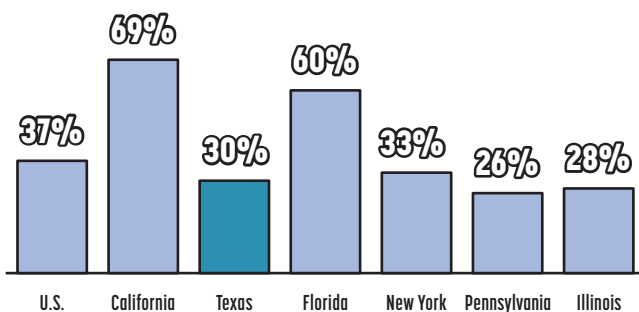
Earnings of 2009 Graduates over 10 Years

States shown in order by size of population

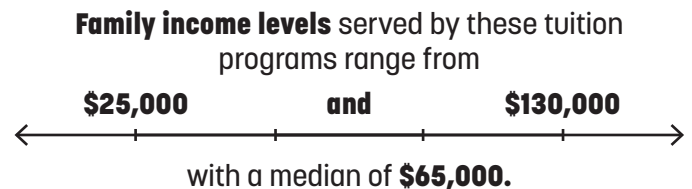
