Program Terminology

Guaranteed Tuition Program
 Provides financial aid assistance for low-and/or
 middle-income students often referred to as a
 promise program by the university.

Guaranteed Tuition Plan
 Locks in tuition and mandatory fees from
 the date of initial enrollment for a period of
 typically 4 years for new undergraduates (also a
 “guaranteed price plan” or “fixed rate tuition”).

Promise Program Partnerships
 Community-driven program featuring
 agreements with specific community colleges
 and universities to provide a last-dollar grant
 that will cover any gap between what a student’s
 state, federal, and institutional financial aid cover
 and the cost of tuition at a Promise Partner
 college (Universities that participate in one or
 more regional promise programs reflect this
 participation, such as the Dallas County Promise,
 Texoma Promise).

Regional Promise Programs
 Provides transfer opportunities with
 community college credits earned first.
 Offered by Red River Promise, Alamo Promise,
 and others.

Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)
 Some universities refer to Family AGI and others
 to Household AGI. Contact the college for
 eligibility and income criteria.

Blue and Gold Guarantee

The Blue and Gold Guarantee assures that tuition and mandatory fees are covered by gift aid (grants, scholarships, exemptions and/or waivers).

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

Covers eight semesters, not including summers, or a bachelor's degree; must complete 24 semester credit hours per academic year (fall/spring)

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- First-time Freshman
- Admitted by May 1
- Federal Pell Grant eligible
- Family Income \$70,000 or less
- Minimum 2.5 institutional GPA

The Lamar Promise Program ensures that sufficient grant and/or scholarship assistance will be provided to cover the full amount of fall and spring in-state tuition and fees for undergraduate Texas residents meeting certain eligibility criteria.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1st time Freshman, seeking first undergraduate degree, and new first time in college freshman or transfer
- Admitted by Feb 1
- Federal Pell Grant eligible
- Be a dependent student per FAFSA
- Household AGI of \$40,000 or less
- Enroll in 15 credit hours within their program of study
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress

Midwestern State University

Mustangs Guarantee Program

Midwestern State University will offer the Mustangs Guarantee Program to students new to MSU who have not previously received a Baccalaureate degree; students must be Texas residents, Pell Grant eligible, and whose family's combined annual Adjusted Gross Income is \$65,000 or less.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

The Mustangs Guarantee Program will cover the remaining balance of any tuition and mandatory fees for 15 or more credit hours each semester for up to four academic years (summer terms and non-MSU enrolled hours are not included) that are NOT covered by other grants, scholarships, exemptions, benefits, and/or waiver programs received by the student.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1st time Freshman, seeking first undergraduate degree, and new first time in college freshman or transfer
- Admitted by March 1 for Fall, Nov 1 for Spring
- Federal Pell Grant eligible
- Be a dependent student per FAFSA
- Household AGI of \$65,000 or less
- Enroll in 15 credit hours each Fall/Spring
- Earn 12 hrs each Fall/Spring
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress

Panther Promise Program

The PVAMU Panther Program guarantees that all participating students are provided with tuition support grants for up to \$2,000 for undergraduate students whose family income is \$30,000 or less. Under the Panther Promise, tuition and mandatory fees will be paid (up to a student's demonstrated need) through a combination of federal, state, and institutional funds. These funds include, but not limited to, Pell Grant, Federal SEOG grant, Texas Grant, Texas Public Educational Grant (TPEG), Institutional scholarships, and federal/state work study.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1st time Freshman, seeking first undergraduate degree
- Complete FAFSA/TAFSA by priority deadline (March 15th)
- Household AGI of \$30,000 or less
- Must demonstrate unmet financial need
- Enroll in 12 credit hours within their program of study
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Renewable for 4 years (consecutive); must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for continued eligibility

The Bearkat Promise guarantees all participating students enough grant funds to cover the cost of mandatory tuition and fees for 15 hours per semester.

- 1st time Freshman or Entering Transfer Students
- Aid application submitted by priority date of March 15 for 2024-2025 academic year
- Household AGI of \$40,000 or less
- Enroll in 12 hrs each Fall/Spring
- Minimum 2.5 GPA for transfer students
- Compliant with SAP policy
- Renewable for 3 years
- Must be a Texas resident who is Pell eligible

Aggie Assurance

Aggie Assurance provides coverage of both tuition and fees for students whose family income is \$60,000 or less. Additionally, tuition support grants are offered to undergraduate students whose family income is greater than \$60,000 but no more than \$130,000. Tuition support grants range from \$500 - \$1,500 based on income and financial need. Students enrolled in a degree-seeking program at College Station, Galveston, or the Health Science Center will be considered for Aggie Assurance. Tuition support grants will continue to be available only to students enrolled at Texas A&M University-College Station.

- Undergraduate seeking first Bachelor's degree at College Station, Galveston, or the Health Science Center
- Complete FAFSA/TASFA by stated deadline on website

Designed specifically for undergraduate transfer students, Central Texas Promise provides a financial guarantee to cover tuition and mandatory fees for eligible students from households with an adjusted gross income of \$40,000 or less.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Degree-seeking Undergraduate Texas resident
- Household AGI \$40,000 or less
- Submit FAFSA by January 15
- Enroll in at least 12 semester credit hours during Fall/Spring and 6 semester credit hours in Summer
- Transfer GPA 2.5 or higher
- Renewals will be granted to eligible students who meet Satisfactory Academic Progress and complete 30 semester credit hours (prorated for spring and summer entry) in the previous academic year.

President's Promise Scholarship

The President's Promise Scholarship is an institutional scholarship awarded to freshman and transfer students who meet specific criteria.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

The scholarship covers all tuition not covered by other grants or scholarships. It will meet 100% of the student's tuition costs for up to four years for new freshmen or up to two years for new transfer students.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- First-time new freshman or first-time new transfer (from a two-year college with an associate degree or earned 45 credit hours)
- Household AGI \$85,000 or less
- FAFSA on file
- Covers full tuition (no fees)
- Pell eligible
- Must enroll and complete 15 semester credit hours at A&M-Commerce during Fall/Spring
- May be combined with Honors College or donor-funded scholarships
- Renewable up to 8 long semesters
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA

The Javelina Promise Program will cover tuition and mandatory fees for eligible students by first applying federal and state aid, such as Pell Grant and TEXAS Grant, scholarships, and other gift aid for up to 8 consecutive fall and spring semesters. Transfer students' program length eligibility will be pro-rated based on credits already earned.

Bobcat Promise

Bobcat Promise guarantees free tuition and mandatory fees for 15 credit hours per semester to new entering freshmen with a family adjusted gross income that does not exceed \$50,000. Under the Bobcat Promise, tuition and mandatory fees will be paid (up to a student's demonstrated need) through a combination of federal, state and institutional funds. These funds include, but are not limited to, Pell Grant, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG), TEXAS Grant, Texas Public Educational Grant (TPEG), Texas State Tuition Grant (TSTG), institutional scholarships, college work-study, etc.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Be an entering first-time freshman (transfer students are not eligible)
- Be a Texas resident
- Have a family-adjusted gross income of \$50,000 or less
- Apply and be accepted for admission, as well as submit a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), no later than March 15 prior to the upcoming academic year
- Have financial need as demonstrated by the FAFSA
- Maintain at least a cumulative 2.0 Texas State GPA (reviewed each May)
- Complete at least 15 credit hours (excluding CLEP courses) each fall and spring semester
- Meet the institutional and program-specific (e.g., Texas Grant) Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements

Texas Promise Facts

Of the 35 general academic public universities in Texas, 34 offer at least one form of guaranteed tuition program.

Family/household income levels served range from \$30,000 to \$130,000, with \$65,000 the median for these programs. Two universities offer a tuition stipend for families earning over \$60,000 and up to \$125,000 or \$130,000. (University of Houston and Texas A&M University, respectively).

Three guaranteed tuition programs serve families with an income of up to \$125,000 (Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi, The University of Texas at Austin, and The University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley).

All of the programs are eligible for freshmen (excluding Texas A&M University – Central Texas, an upper-level campus).

Three programs require Top 25% high school ranking for consideration (Tarleton State University, Texas A&M International University, and The University of Texas at San Antonio). Of these, Texas A&M International University offers minimum test score achievement as a substitute for Top 25% standing. Additionally, Texas A&M University – San Antonio's program is open to Top 10% students and Top 11 – 35% students with a family AGI of \$70,000 or less. And, The University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley requires Top 10% standing or a test score substitute for program eligibility.
